Ocean's Edge Gallery Tour: up to 1 Hour, \$10.00 per person (plus Aquarium admission)

This basic tour is a great way to get a full introduction to the Ocean's Edge. It includes an introduction to the Aquarium and a tour of the galleries which includes the Kelp Forest and a Behind the Scenes opportunity.

Full Aquarium Tour: Up to 2 Hours, \$20.00 per person (plus Aquarium admission)

For groups that want to explore the Aquarium with a guide during the majority of their visit to the Aquarium, this extended tour is the best option. This includes a full introduction to the Aquarium, exploring both the Ocean's Edge and Open Sea Galleries, and a Behind the Scenes opportunity.

Accommodation can be made for groups before and after Aquarium public hours for an additional fee of \$10.00 extra per person (subject to Aquarium availability).
