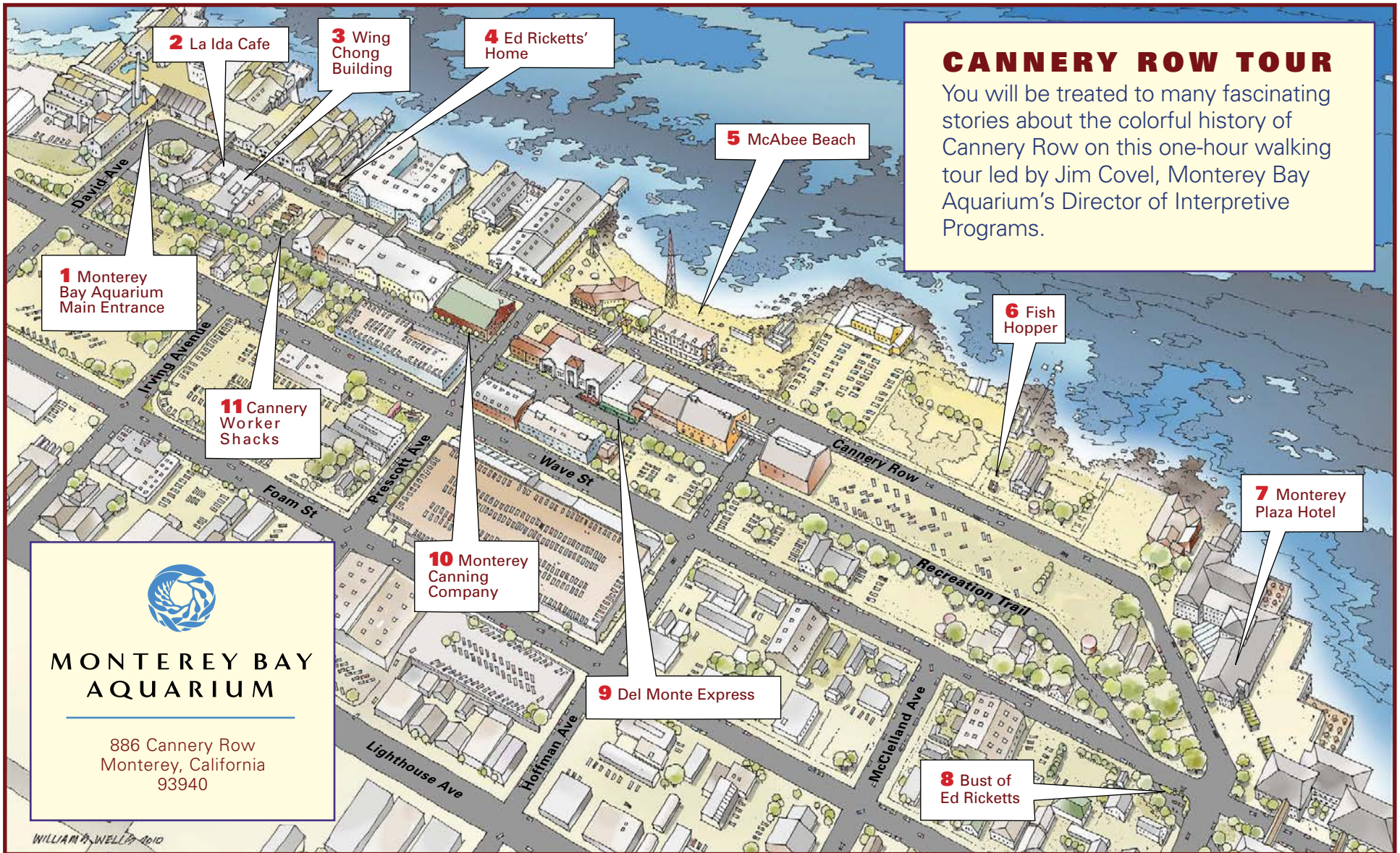


# WALKING TOURS FROM THE MONTEREY BAY AQUARIUM

**CANNERY ROW TOUR**  
 You will be treated to many fascinating stories about the colorful history of Cannery Row on this one-hour walking tour led by Jim Covel, Monterey Bay Aquarium's Director of Interpretive Programs.

**1 Aquarium Entry:** Begin this walking tour at the front entrance to the Monterey Bay Aquarium looking out to where David Street and Cannery Row intersect

**2 La Ida Café:** Made infamous in Steinbeck's *Cannery Row*

**3 Wing Chong Building:** Site of the Wing Chong Market, a favorite shopping spot for many of Steinbeck's characters

**4 Ed Ricketts Home:** This is where Doc Ricketts lived and ran his business, the Pacific Biological Supply

**5 McAbee Beach:** A little pocket beach with a rich natural and human history

**6 Fish Hopper:** A simple but elegant solution that improved the productivity of the canneries

**7 Monterey Plaza Hotel:** An elegant setting with an interesting past and a breathtaking view

**8 Bust of Ed Ricketts:** A tragic loss for the community is memorialized at this site

**9 Del Monte Express:** A remnant of the train that served the Monterey Peninsula

**10 Monterey Canning Company:** Learn about what happened to the sardine industry

**11 Cannery Worker Shacks:** Examples of seasonal cannery worker housing that previously dotted the hillsides
